On September 13, 2023, an emergency preparedness exercise for hazardous materials was conducted by Greenville County at the former County Square building before its demolition. This exercise was funded by the Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant, provided by the US Department of Transportation, which was approved by Greenville County Council.

During the exercise scenario, a caller reported a disturbance in an office down the hall, possibly involving an armed assailant. As the situation developed, it became clear that the Greenville County Sheriff's Office would need additional support from the county due to hazardous materials.

The Greenville County Sheriff's Office SWAT team was able to rescue any victims located inside the building during the initial sweep. Once the victims were brought outside, they were triaged and treated by Greenville County Emergency Medical Services.

Inside the building, a member of the SWAT Team from the Greenville County Sheriff's Office was instructed to pretend to be unconscious after encountering dangerous materials. To locate the deputy and the hazardous materials, the Greenville County Sheriff's Office Drone Team used drones to search the area.

Once the Greenville County Sheriff's Office Drone Team located the chemicals, the HAZMAT team was able to enter the building to sample, test, and identify the chemicals. After the HAZMAT team identified the chemicals, Emergency Medical Services were able to treat the victims for chemical inhalation.

For this exercise to be successful, the Greenville County Sheriff's Office SWAT and Drone Team, Emergency Medical Services, Special Operations, Community Emergency Response Team, and Greenville City Fire Department were all involved.

HIGH DIRECTIONAL TRAINING

On September 14, 2023, the Greenville County Emergency Response Team and SC Task Force 6 trained on high-directional anchors using the Arizona Vortex and the TerrAdaptor.

The Arizona Vortex can be used in a variety of situations including mountain and confined space rescue as well as rope and work access. The TerrAdaptor is the most versatile portable anchor system available for use in rescue, industrial and wilderness environments.
