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GSP Command and Control Course

Greenville County Emergency Management staff had the opportunity to attend the Critical Incident: Command and Control course on August 6, 2026, hosted by Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport (GSP). We appreciate GSP for extending the invitation to Greenville County agencies and fostering regional collaboration. The course focused on command and control during the critical first hour of a major incident, emphasizing unified command, interagency coordination, and decision-making under rapidly evolving conditions. Instructors from 1st 60 Emergency Response Consulting led participants through a realistic, hands-on scenario that brought together law enforcement, fire, EMS, and emergency management professionals to reinforce best practices for unified command and strengthen partnerships that enhance our community's preparedness and response capabilities.
